INTERNET SURFING AND USE OF E-MAIL

It has come to my attention that unproductive and inappropriate use is being made of both the Web and e-mail.

Please draft guidelines covering the use of the web and e-mail within the company. Staff should be informed that we have recently purchased software that allows our computer controller to monitor what websites employee visit. Furthermore, they should be told that is now possible to see how long each site was visited, on what day it was visited and what each employee did when they were at a particular site.

On a cautionary note, I enclose a copy of the statement issued by IMPACT, the union that represents public service clerical workers. You will note that they consider that e-mail should be afforded the same privacy as normal post.
